याचिकाकर्ताओं द्वारा शासन के समक्ष 7 दिन में पक्ष रखने एवं
शासन द्वारा उचित कार्यवाही के संदर्भ में।

महोदय जी,

निवेदन है कि राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन के अन्तर्गत कम्युनिटी
हेल्थ ऑफिसर (सी.एच.ओ.) की पोस्ट के लिए विज्ञापन दिनांक
23/10/2019 को निकाला गया था जिसमें इन पदों में बी.एस.सी.
नर्सिंग और आयुष से सिर्फ आयुर्वेद चिकित्सकों को लिया गया है।
चूंकि आयुष में होम्योपैथी के चिकित्सक भी आते हैं और आयुर्वेद के
समान ही साढ़े पांच वर्ष की पढाई करते हैं।

जिसके लिए हम लोगों को राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन द्वारा यह
तर्क दिया गया था कि आपकी सेन्ट्रल काउंसिल ऑफ होम्योपैथी ने

इसकी अनुमति नहीं दी है, इसलिए आप लोगों को शामिल नहीं किया जा रहा है। जबकि सेन्ट्रल काउंसिल ऑफ होम्योपैथी ने एन.ओ. सी. दिनांक 03/04/2018 को सभी स्टेट के हायरेक्टर हेल्थ और सेक्रेटरी हेल्थ को भेज दिये गये हैं साथ ही स्टेट काउंसिल ऑफ होम्योपैथी ने भी इसकी अनुमति दिनांक 05/11/2019 को दे दी है। इन दोनों पत्र की प्रति आवेदन के साथ लगी हुई है।

इसके अलावा भी विभिन्न संगठनों द्वारा पत्रों के माध्यम से राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन को कई ज्ञापन दिये गये हैं इनकी प्रति भी संलग्न है। परन्तु इसके बावजूद भी बी.एच.एम.एस. चिकित्सकों को शामिल नहीं किया गया।

अतः मजबूरीवश हमें माननीय उच्च न्यायालय की शरण में जाना पडा जिसकी पहली सुनवाई दिनांक 08/11/2019 को हुई जिसमें हमें राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन के द्वारा जानकारी दी गयी कि हम फेज सिस्टम में भर्ती कर रहे हैं और अगले पदों में बी.एच.एम.एस. को भी शामिल कर लेंगे लेकिन दूसरी सुनवाई दिनांक 13/11/2019 में हमें कहा गया कि हम राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन की ऑपरेशनल गाइड लाइन में नहीं है जबकि नेशनल हेल्थ पॉलिसी 2017 में पूर्ण आयुष का नाम है इसकी प्रति भी पत्र के साथ संलग्न है और ऑपरेशनल गाईडलाईन इसी पालिसी के आधार पर बनी है पर इसमें बी.एच.एम.एस चिकित्सकों को छोड दिया गया है जो न्याय संगत नहीं है साथ ही सामानता के अधिकार का हनन है इसकी अगली सुनवाई

दिनांक 02.12.19 को हुई जिसमें राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन म.प्र. द्वारा राष्ट्रीय स्वास्थ्य मिशन डायरेक्टर दिल्ली द्वारा जारी पत्र जो दिनांक 02.11.2019 को दिया गया है को प्रस्तुत किया।

जिसमें कहा गया है कि आप लोगों को इसलिये सम्मिलित नहीं किया गया है कि बी.एच.एम.एस चिकित्सक सीमित मात्रा में जनरल सर्जिकल प्रोसिजर इमरजेन्सी मेनेजमेंट और इमर्जेन्सी केस जैसे बर्न, ट्रामा के बारे नहीं पढा जाता है ये जानकारी बिना तथ्य के दी गई है जो कि पूर्ण रूप से भ्रामक है। चूंकि बी.एच.एम.एस अपने पूर्ण साढे पांच वर्ष की पढाई में सभी मॉडर्न सब्जेक्ट के साथ सर्जरी भी पढते हैं जिसमें सर्जिकल प्रोसिजर इमर्जेन्सी मेनेजमेंट एवं इमर्जेन्सी केस जैसे बर्न, ट्रामा भी पढते है साथ ही ई.एन.टी. और आब्स एण्ड गायनी भी पढाई जाती है जो कि

एम.बी.बी.एस. के सिलेबस के लगभग बराबर है। बी.एच.एम.एस. के चिकित्सकों के सिलेबस भी पत्र के साथ संलग्न है।

अतः महोदय जी से निवेदन है कि स्वास्थ्य राज्य का मुद्दा है और राज्य सरकार को अधिकार है कि वो केन्द्र से हटकर भी अपनी हेल्थ पॉलिसी बनाकर इसमें बी.एच.एम.एस. चिकित्सकों को भी जोड सकती हैं। इसी तरह बिहार सरकार ने भी सकारात्मक निर्णय लेते हुये बी.एच.एम.एस. चिकित्सकों को भी शामिल किया गया है। साथ ही इसी तरह ही निर्णय भारत सरकार ने भी लेते हुये यूनार्न

possessing the bachelor degree in Homeopathy but they are not being allowed to participate in the said training and as such, they are being deprived to get the appointment on the post of Community Health Officer.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the Central Council of Homeopathy which is a recognized parent body for the field of Homeopathy wrote a letter on 03.04.2018 (Annexure-P/5) to the Authorities of the respondent/State requesting them that in the Bridge Programme in Community Health, the candidate belonging to BHMS (Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine and Surgery) be also considered because it is realized by the Council as per its meeting held on 10.01.2018 that the syllabus prescribed for the course of BHMS is much higher in standard than the course requisite for the Bridge Programme in Community Health for Nurses and Ayurveda Practitioner. From the said letter, it reveals that the Education Committee of the Council has also decided to apprise the aforesaid issue to the Authorities of the National Health Mission (respondent No.2). The learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the National Health Policy was issued in the year 2017 (Annexure-P/7) in which it is clearly provided that for the Bridge Courses, admission could be given to the graduates from different clinical and paramedical background like AAYUSH Doctors, B.Sc.(Nurses) and Pharmacist etc. He tries to emphasize that BHMS is a part of AAYUSH, therefore, respondent No.2 cannot discriminate the candidates belonging to BHMS course depriving them to participate in the training of the Bridge Course. He further submits that other High Courts have considered the request of similar nature and provisionally allowed the candidates belonging of BHMS course to participate in the training programme and, therefore, the petitioners should also be given the same treatment by allowing them to participate in the said training.

As in the both the petitions, common question is involved, therefore, they are being decided concomitantly and for the purpose of convenience, facts of Writ Petition No.23338/2019 are taken note of.

2. Since reply as well as additional reply on behalf of respondent No.2 who is the contesting party has already been filed and the learned counsel for the parties are ready to argue the matter finally, therefore, it is heard finally.

3. By the instant petition, the petitioners are challenging the advertisement dated 23.10.2019 (Annexure-P/1) issued by respondent No.2 whereby applications for the post of Community Health Officer had been invited and before appointment to the said post under the programme for health and wellness, a certificate course has to be organized for which the candidates have to go for six months' training. As per the impugned advertisement, the essential qualification is prescribed as B.Sc.(Nursing) and BAMS passed from the institution recognized from the Bhartiya Chikitsa Kendriya Parishad, New Delhi. The petitioners are

Sub:- Bridge Programme in Community Health – regarding.

Madam/Sir,

I am to say that the Education Committee of this Council in its meeting held on 10.1.2018 discussed the matter of Bridge Programme in Community Health for Nurses and for Ayurvedic Practitioners and request for allowing the said programme for Homoeopathic Practitioners and it resolved as under:-

"The Committee have gone through the above mentioned Bridge programme and also the syllabus prescribed for the BHMS Course in the subject of Community Medicine, and after threadbare long discussion amongst its members, the Education Committee decided as under:-

1. The Syllabus prescribed by the Central Council of Homoeopathy for BHMS Course in the subject of Community Medicine (which includes Homoeopathic orientation also) is much higher in standards than the course contents for Bridge Programme in Community Health for Nurses and Ayurvedic Practitioners.

The Committee observed that one year compulsory rotating internship programme for BHMS Course includes rotation of internship in Community Medicine (including PHC/CHC) and they have to maintain records of knowledge gained by them in Primary Health Centre, Community Health Centre and various Health Programme.

In syllabus of Community Medicine for BHMS Course it has been specifically instructed for teaching and training to follow as under:-

"Instruction

- (a) Physician's function is not limited merely prescribing homoeopathic medicines for curative purpose but he has wider role to play in the community.
- (b) He has to be well conversant with the National Health Problems of rural as well as urban areas, so that he can be assigned responsibilities to play an effective role not only in the field of curative but also preventive and social medicine including family planning.

II. This subject is of at most importance and throughout the period of study attention of the students should be directed towards the importance of preventive medicine and the measures for promotion of positive health

III(a) During teaching, focus should be laid on Community Medicine concept, man and society, aim and scope of preventive and social medicine, social causes of disease and social problems of the sick, relation of economic factors and environment and health and diseases."

2. The Committee also decided that the Council may apprise the concerned authorities of National Health Mission, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India and the concerned authorities of State Govts. about the syllabus and training programme in community medicine in BHMS Course [including Annexure-A and Annexure-B of Regulation 3(ii) of Homoeopathy (Degree Course) BHMS Regulations, 1983 (as amended upto March, 2016)]. A copy of the syllabus of Community Medicine and Annexure-A & Annexure-B may also provided to the authorities.
3. The Committee also opined that over and above the knowledge and training imparted to the BHMS students in community medicine, if any such training is required as per the local needs where the Homoeopathic Practitioners need to serve the community, the concerned Govt. may provide such training to such Homoeopathic Practitioners."

above said matter was placed before the Central Council in its meeting held on 12.03.2018, wherein the Council agreed with the resolution adopted by the Education Committee in its meeting held on 10.1.2018 and it has decided that the practitioners of Homoeopathy should be restricted to Homoeopathic practice only.

The Council has also decided to convey the provisions of Section 15(2) of HCC Act, 1973 and Regulation 12(4) of Homoeopathy (Degree Course) BHMS Regulations, 1983 (professional conduct, etiquette and code of ethics) and to forward a copy of Ministry's letter No.H.11016/6/93-Homoeo dated 23.3.94 to the concerned authority of National Health Mission, Govt. of India and the concerned authorities of State/U.T. Governments.

Therefore, requested to take necessary action in the matter.

Enclosed herewith –





Subject: Clarification on eligibility for Certificate Programme in Community Health-Reg.

Please refer to your letter No. HWC/13304, dated 8th November 2019 regarding selection of BHMS, BDS and Pharmacy graduates in Certificate Course in Community Health.


2. In this regard, as previously communicated, it is stated that review of the Homeopathic curriculum reveals that there is limited focus on general surgical procedures, management of medical emergencies, and emergency cases related to burns and trauma. Also it focuses only on Pharmacology of homeopathic medicine medicines.


3. Further, review of the curriculum for Bachelors and Diploma in Pharmacy (D.Pharma and B.Pharma) Degree Course indicates that emphasis on other clinical disciplines such as General Medicine, General Surgery, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Paediatrics, Mental Health and Preventive and Social medicine/ Community health are not covered in the course design.

4. These skills are critical to master the competencies of Certificate Programme in Community Health to deliver.

5. Please take note that as per the Sub-Section 4.1 of the Section 4 of Ayushman Bharat: Comprehensive Primary Health Care through Health and Wellness Centres- Operational Guideline, a Community Health Officer (CHO) would be a BSc. in Community Health or a Nurse (GNM or B.SC) or an Ayurveda practitioner, trained and certified through IGNOU/other State Public Health/Medical Universities for a set of competencies in delivering public health and primary health care services.



A. ABOUT THE COURSE

Background: Trained and competent human resources are essential for an effective health care delivery system. There is a pressing need to strengthen health sub centres to provide Comprehensive Primary Care including for NCDs. Global evidence suggests that suitably trained service providers can provide considerable primary care. For this qualified AYUSH (Ayurvedic/Homeopathic/Unani) doctors who could be trained in public health & primary care through suitably designed 'Certificate in Community Health are posted at Health & Wellness Centre to serve the communities.

The B.Sc (CH) Curriculum is the benchmark for developing this bridge course and these pass out Mid Level Health Provides will be primarily deployed at Health & Wellness Centres. They would possess the necessary knowledge and competencies to deliver comprehensive primary care services and implement public health programmes.

Course Outline: The Certificate Programmes will be conducted by IGNOU. Theory classes and hands-on Practicum training will be organized at Program Study Centres and Health Centres (District Hospitals, CHCs, PHCs, Sub Centres, etc.) identified and accredited by IGNOU. In addition to this there would be community visits by students for field-based assignments and research projects.

Working regular Ayurvedic/Homeopathic/Unani doctor under Govt. of Bihar or,
Working contractual Ayurvedic/ Homeopathic/Unani doctor under NHM/ Govt. of Bihar or,

Medium of Instruction: English/ Hindi for teaching as well as assessments

Course Duration: Six months

Academic Session: January 2020 to June 2020.

Course Objectives: Based on the gaps identified through curriculum mapping between B.Sc (CH) and AYUSH (Ayurveda/Homeopath/Unani) courses, the program would broadly cover the following:

- Introduction to National Health Programs & Health Systems and adherence to national protocols of treatment and care, development of leadership and management skills for effective functioning of H&WCs.
- Public Health Competencies such as understanding the history & evolution of public health in India, analysis of health profile of district, state & country, methods to improve health seeking behaviour, health promotion, nutritional assessment, promotion, education and rehabilitation, use of basic epidemiological tools, morbidity and mortality profiling of community/district, reproductive and child health.

Community Health Officers (CHOs) to lead a primary care provider team consisting of female health workers (ANMs), male health worker (MPW), ASHAs, etc.

Job Responsibilities: The trained CHO would broadly be expected to carry out public health functions, ambulatory care, management and leadership at the Health & Wellness Centres (H&WCs). They would be expected to:

- a) Implement National Programmes
- b) Administration and management at Health and Wellness Centres.
- c) Health education and encourage awareness about Family Planning, Maternal and Child Health, and Non-Communicable Diseases.
- d) Preventive, promotive and curative care
- e) Identification of Danger Signs and Referral after pre-referral stabilization



- I. Eligible candidates may submit their applications online only at State Health Society Website in the Link – **HR Cell of the society's official website www.statehealthsocietybihar.org on or before 10th January, 2020 and 06:00 PM.**
- II. **APPLICATION FEE:**
